

SAMPLE GIFT IN WILL (BEQUEST) CLAUSES

1: PECUNIARY BEQUEST (A SPECIFIED SUM OF MONEY)

I GIVE to Hagar New Zealand Charitable Trust, Charity Registration Number: CC50258, the sum of \$xxx (AMOUNT IN WORDS) for its general purposes and declare that the receipt of Hagar New Zealand Charitable Trust will be a full discharge to my Trustee(s).

2: RESIDUARY BEQUEST (A PERCENTAGE OF THE ESTATE RESIDUE)

Note: If the Will-maker wishes to give say 10% of their estate to Hagar and the draftsperson has divided the residue into 100 parts with an accruer clause (a clause that apportions any part that fails amongst the others that don't fail) then an appropriate clause is as follows:

I GIVE ten (10) of such parts to Hagar New Zealand Charitable Trust, Charity Registration Number: CC50258, for its general purposes and declare that the receipt of the Trustees of Hagar New Zealand Charitable Trust will be a full discharge to my Trustee(s).
